The Little Miami Local School District will appoint a pest manager. The appointed manager will routinely inspect the buildings for pest activity. The pest manager will promptly respond to any reported pest complaints. The first step to the Integrated Pest Management Program is to eliminate the source of the problem(s) without using pesticides. When nontoxic methods fail, the least toxic pesticide that is effective and approved will be used. Only trained and qualified workers will handle and apply pesticides. A school employee should always be

present to watch over all IPM service provider visits. The provider will avoid spraying pesticides when children and staff are present. Pesticides shouldn't be sprayed during school hours or when school activities are taking place. Treated areas will have restricted access as recommended on the pesticide label.

The district will keep a record and detailed description of any or all pesticides used in or around school facilities.
