Bond refinancing saves \$4.2 million

Little Miami will save several million dollars of taxpayer money when it refinances two bonds in the coming months.

Treasurer Terry Gonda and the Board of Education are taking advantage of lower rates on two general obligation bonds. When districts have large projects that they are not able to pay for in one lump sum, they use a bond to finance the project and pay on that debt for many years.

In 2006, Little Miami voters approved a \$62.5 million, 28-year tax issue for construction of the current junior high school, intermediate school, the

addition to the high school, and renovations to the other buildings.

Refinancing to a lower bond rate will save taxpayers a projected \$4.2 million over the life of the debt.
