Board Work Session

Hamilton Township Enterprise Zone: Mr. Power said that he had a conversation with Ray Warrick, Hamilton Twp. Administrator, and the trustees did not discuss or take action on the enterprise zone at their Jan. 4 meeting. Mr. Haas said that it appears that Bruce Rippe's project may not be able to move forward as first planned, and the project may now turn into multi-family housing.

The Board decided to table the enterprise zone discussion until further notice.

Budget Discussion: Mr. Gonda presented the five percent and 5.5 percent budget models. Mr. Power presented the proposed district staffing plan for the 2017-18 school year as background information for the Board as they consider budget models. Mr. Power said the district was projecting the need to hire about four new teachers for next year, along with an additional tech person. Mrs. Journeay clarified that this projection was based on current enrollment. Mr. Power said he would like to bring the finalized staffing plan to the board in March.

General discussion followed regarding budget models and enrollment growth. The Board said they felt most comfortable with the 5.5 percent growth model, and felt that gave them the best footing for coming contract negotiations in March. Mr. Gonda provided several scenarios for those negotiations for the board's information. Any other model, Mr. Haas said, and the district would be eating into its fund balance too quickly.
