The Super Saturday Program is an enrichment program for intellectually gifted children, ages 4-14, in the Greater Cincinnati area.

At The Super Saturday Program, children can explore established and new areas of interest while surrounded by their gifted peers. Classes are held six Saturdays each fall, winter, and spring, with both morning and afternoon classes.

The Super Saturday Program is presented by the Parent Association for Gifted Education, Inc (PAGE), which is a 501(c)(3) all-volunteer nonprofit corporation. Parents are encouraged to volunteer their time and talents to help keep the program running smoothly and can learn more on campus.

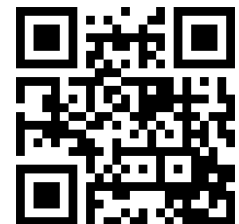

Be a Podcaster

Missing cookies, Forensic Techniques, Encrypted messages, suspenseful games, and colorful chromatography are just a clue about what awaits you in Mystery Mayhem.

Making Monsters

With Halloween around the corner, let's make our own costumes and props. Cheetahs, dragons, ghouls, and superheroes are on the prowl. LEGO Mindstorm Robotics

Learn to use motors, sensors and gears to design and build a unique LEGO robot each class to master weekly challenges. Learn gearing, create robot attachments, compete in games, races, heavy weight challenges, and much, much more! Then combine all the skills you've learned to create your ultimate robot for an epic Battle Bots competition!

Deconstruction in Reverse

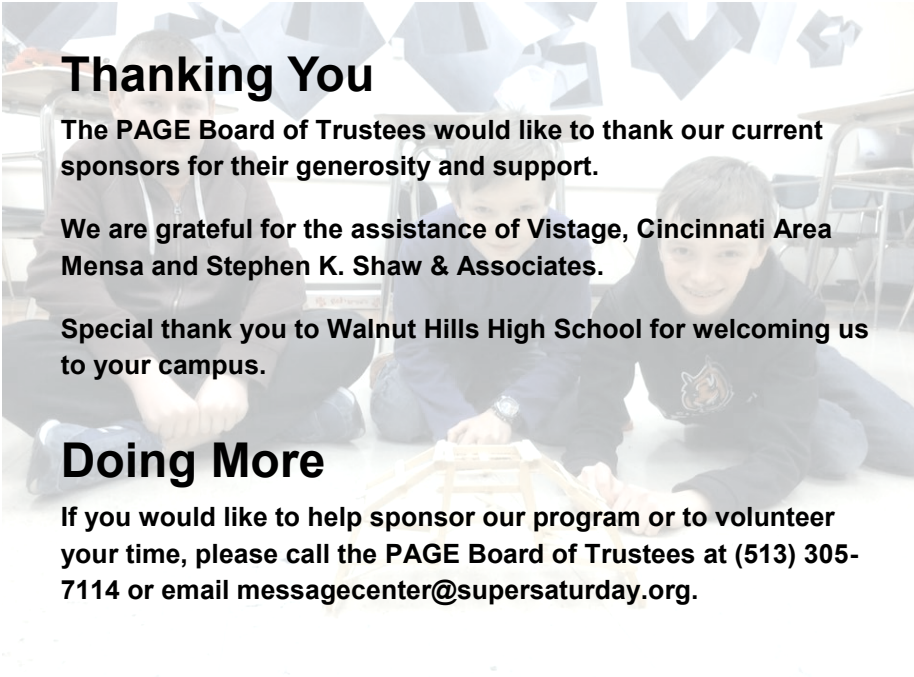
