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STUDENT DRIVING REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

Parking in the school student parking lot is considered a privilege, which may be revoked or suspended for various rule infractions including, but not limited to the following:

1. Failure to pay current school year fees by the end of the semester.
2. Repeated tardiness.
3. Reckless operation or license suspension.
4. Truancy from school or assigned class period.
 - a. First offense-permit suspended for remainder of semester
 - b. Second offense-permit revoked for remainder of school year
5. Failure to obey parking lot supervisor
6. Spinning or squealing tires
7. Repeated warnings for loud music
8. Parking in unauthorized area or in teacher parking lot
9. Loitering in car or in student parking lot area before or after school
10. Repeated tardiness to class
11. Other major violations of the Student Code of Conduct

NOTE: Permit holders are not permitted to transfer their permit to other students. Non-permit holders who continue to drive to school will be considered insubordinate and will be punished in accordance with the code of conduct. Their vehicles may be towed from the student lot at the owner's expense.

Added items of note:

1. All vehicles must display the permit tag on rearview mirror on a daily basis or they will be denied access to the student parking lot. Tag must be visible through the windshield.
2. Cars must yield right of way to school buses at all times.
3. All cars using the school parking lot must be covered by insurance. **THE SCHOOL IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS OUT OF STUDENTS VEHICLES DURING ANY TIME IT IS PARKED ON SCHOOL PROPERTY. LOCK YOUR CAR!**
4. There is to be no loitering in the school parking lot or in automobiles. Once school is dismissed, all students are expected to leave school grounds unless they have official business to attend to. Students should not arrive prior to 7:00 AM. Once a student arrives at school, they may not leave and re-enter the school parking lot before school starts.
5. Tobacco is not permitted in cars on school grounds by drivers or passengers.
6. Maximum speed in the parking lot is 10 MPH. Reckless driving will not be tolerated and will result in revocation of student parking privileges. This includes, but is not limited to: squealing tires, speeding, failure to obey parking lot supervisor, parking in unauthorized areas and driving recklessly.
7. Hunting rifles, shotguns, bow and arrows and any other dangerous instrument as outlined in rule #4 of the student handbook are prohibited in school and on school property. This prohibition includes student vehicles.
8. Students will not be permitted to retrieve forgotten items from their cars during the school day.
9. Student vehicles may be subject to search as part of our responsibility for keeping the school safe.
