Buildings & grounds

As of today, Little Miami Local Schools will remain closed through April 3, with **ONE exception**: The buildings will be open on Tuesday, March 17 during regular school hours. Tomorrow's time is set aside for families to retrieve any medication from our school nurses and for our staff and students to retrieve any essential personal items from the buildings. ***Visitors are asked to stop in, collect their items and go.*** While in our buildings, please strive to maintain the social distancing so that all can remain safe. No medications will be sent home with children.

As per the Ohio Secretary of State's office, tomorrow's primary election will go on as scheduled. This means three of our buildings (Salem Twp. Elementary, Little Miami Intermediate and Little Miami High School) will be open as polling places.
