Important Food Services Info for Next School Year

For the past two years, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has offered waivers to Child Nutrition (CN) Programs across the United States, allowing these programs to offer all students breakfast and lunch, at no charge. These waivers will expire on the last day of school or June 30, 2022, whichever comes first. This means that starting



next school year, 2022-2023, **Child Nutrition programs across the nation will return to normal, prepandemic operations of charging families for meals at school.** Families will once again be asked to complete and submit a current school year Free/Reduced Meal Application to learn if their students qualify.
