#### 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Honors English

- We are happy to announce that to better serve our students and provide them with greater opportunities to expand the depth and rigor of our English Language Arts curriculum, we are introducing Honors English for those students entering 7th and 8th grades for the 2024-2025 school year.
- **Course description** Honors English focuses on the central themes of maturation, diversity, and the development of compassion, empathy, and respect for others. The curriculum teaches the skills of reading, writing, discussion, language use, and vocabulary development through the study of both literature and informational texts. Core readings include novels, plays, short stories, and poetry. Students will be asked to explore additional works of literature as well. The writing modes targeted are expository and fictional/personal narrative. Honors English serves as both an introduction to the high school English curriculum as well as an opportunity for students to critically explore their maturation process through the lens of literature.

The rigors of the course are intended to be commensurate with the preparation students need for success later in high school, in college, and the working world. Students are being trained to be excellent critical thinkers, readers, textual analysts, writers, and creative producers of argument. The course will demand both high quantity and quality of effective writing for a range of audiences and purposes. By so writing, students will demonstrate their mastery of the conventions of the standard written language. Through the coursework, students will be expected to meet and exceed state standards for reading, writing, listening, speaking, and language.

 Teacher Recommendation – Students will indicate the teacher they would like the English Language Arts Department to contact to provide a recommendation on their application form. The **preference** is that this is a current English Language Arts Teacher, but the recommendation **must** come from a teacher at Little Miami Middle School who has taught the student.

- 1. Read and annotate an assigned book over the summer- **Incoming 8th graders only.**
- 2. Be comfortable doing homework outside of school hours due to increased workload.
- 3. Be an independent learner and strong collaborator.
- 4. Have a strong work ethic.
- 5. Be organized, and have good time management, and self-discipline.
- 6. Be reflective and appreciate constructive feedback.
- 7. Be resourceful, respectful, and a problem solver.
- 8. Will meet deadlines on assignments.
