## **State Testing Reminders and Modified Schedules:**

- We are in the midst of state testing. Students should come to testing day with their computers charged after eating a healthy breakfast!
- 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:
  - On the days of your students' tests, they will arrive at school at the normal drop-off time. They will then take their test, as an entire grade, at the start of the school day.
  - o After testing sessions conclude, we will begin a modified schedule that includes all class periods.
  - On days your student <u>does not</u> test, they have the option to arrive at school later without missing any classes or being counted as tardy.
- <u>6th-grade students will arrive at regular time on all days and will have a modified</u> schedule after their testing session.
