Little Miami Local Schools Community Meeting November 1, 2016 Survey Results

The following are the results of the survey conducted at the Little Miami Local Schools Community Meeting led by Emersion and Fanning Howey on Tuesday, November 1, 2016. The School District convened the forum as part of the process to develop its Facility Master Plan. More than 50 people attended the Community Meeting. Using TurningPoint, an interactive software system, Community Forum attendees were asked a series of questions regarding academics, facilities, and other topics for Little Miami Local Schools. The questions were designed to collect and prioritize the community's desires for educating the children of Little Miami. Each attendee was given a "clicker," which allowed them to respond individually and anonymously to each question.

Please note that the survey is not intended to be a scientific study. The results only represent the total number of attendee responses to each question. Some attendees choose not to respond to all questions. Therefore, the total number of responses varies by question. In addition, there are some questions involving prioritizing which allowed respondents to provide more than one response to a question. As a result, percentages for some questions may exceed one hundred percent.
