Notification System Test on October 20

On Wednesday, October 20th, 2021 at approximately 10 a.m., Little Miami Local Schools will be conducting a test of the district notification system via phone call, email, and text. Those listed as "Parent/Legal Guardian" and/or "Same as Student Address" in their student's Student Information profile should receive the notification.



The test will read: "This is a test of the Little Miami Local Schools notification system. There is no emergency, this is just a test. No action is required. Thank you."

This test is to prepare & improve LM's emergency communication capabilities prior to a true emergency and in readiness for the inclement winter weather season. Those who do not receive the notification on October 20th, are asked to email communications@lmsdoh.org with their name, contact info, and name of their student(s) to ensure they are included on future communications.

How much Federal Aid can I receive?

- In general, it depends on the financial need.
- Financial need is determined by Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and the Cost of Attendance (COA).
- EFC is determined by the information reported on the FAFSA form [Study Here](#)
- COA includes tuition and fees, room and board, transportation, etc.
- $COA - EFC = \text{financial need}$ (out of pocket costs)

Pick-up donated costumes at the Morrow Train Depot 10-16-21 and 10-17-21 from 1-3pm.

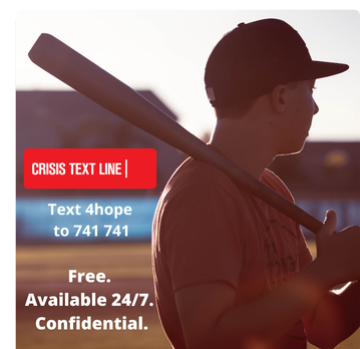


Crisis Text Line - "4hope" to 741 741
