Progress Book Access

Little Miami utilizes a program called Progress Book to track assignments and grades. Parents have access to this tool and it is highly recommended that you log in regularly to track your child's progress. Logins follow a student through their years at Little Miami. All parents were given registration information and an access code to create an account when they began at Little Miami. If you are new to the district or perhaps have never created an account, please contact our school secretary, Mrs. Gayle Scott, for a copy of your access code.



Nurse Notes:

Please be aware that the school nurse cannot administer a medication, nor can a student self-carry a medication, without a form signed by a parent and doctor to do so. Bear in mind that any previous school medication orders do not carry over to the next year. The school does not supply medication and it would need to be brought to the school. Please contact the school if a form is needed and the nurse will assist with this.

Illnesses are already paving way in the community and it's important to work together to decrease the spread. The following guidelines will help you determine when to send or keep a child home from school.

- Must be fever free (without medication) for 24 hours before returning to school. A temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit is considered a fever.
- Must be free of vomiting and/or diarrhea for 24 hours.
- If diagnosed with a strep infection, must be on an antibiotic for a minimum of 24 hours.
- Please keep a child home with a heavy, moist productive cough, chest congestion, or discolored nasal drainage.
- Please keep a child home with red, inflamed eyes, persistent irritation, and or thick/discolored eye drainage. If your child has pinkeye (conjunctivitis), they need to have completed 24 hours of medication.

The clinic tries to provide clothing to students, as needed. To be able to keep up with a steady stream of needs, donations are appreciated. We would appreciate donations of lightly used boys and girls shorts, sizes 5-10, preferably elastic waist and not jeans. Boys and girls shoes are also in need, sizes 12-4.
