Senior Community Service

-12 hours of Community Service is required of all seniors to graduate.

-No more than 6 hours in any one thing with a few exceptions:

Eagle Scout

Military that starts in high school (drills etc.)

Mission trip

Extensive hospital/nursing home volunteering

-Donating blood:

-if you donate at school, I get a list and you don't need an individual paper signed

-if you donate at Hoxworth, bring the paper they give you

Additional information:

Student aide-3 hours per semester during your senior year

Choir, National Honor Society etc.-The Community Service you do

with those organizations does count.

-You must find your own Community Service. If a call is received looking for volunteers it will be on Schoology

-Community Service forms are located in the Main Office, Guidance Office or Ms. Stein's room, room 230.

-Community Service forms are to be turned into Ms.- Stein in room 230 or put in my mailbox.

-Community Service is due on the last school day of March. You will NOT receive your cap and gown until it is complete.
