

Dear WCCC Senior Parents:

Graduation is rapidly approaching. I would like to inform you of the details for this year's graduation. Graduation will be held at Wright State University's Nutter Center on Sunday, May 19 at 6:00. Graduates must report to the Nutter Center by 5:00. The doors open to the public at 5:00; parents are advised to be present by 5:45 p.m. We will start promptly at 6:00, so please be sure to be on time. No tickets are needed for seating, as there is plenty of seating for graduates to invite as many people as they'd like. There is handicapped seating available. Nutter Center ushers will be at all entrances and can escort families to these sections.

Mandatory graduation practice will be held in the Little Miami multipurpose room on **Friday, May 17 at 8:00 a.m.** Graduates **MUST** be on time. All seniors are to stay for the entire practice. If a graduate works or has other daytime commitments, arrangements must be made with his/her employer so that he/she may attend practice.

Any student who does not attend the practice will NOT be allowed to participate in the ceremony.

If your child is participating in both the WCCC ceremony and the LMHS ceremony, the fee is \$20.00. If your child is participating in the WCCC ceremony only, there is no fee. This fee pays for the items needed for the commencement ceremony. This fee needs to be given to Clarissa Walls-Parker, the guidance office secretary. (LMHS students pay this same fee, but it is added to their 2nd semester fees).

Seniors are also invited to come to LMHS on Thursday, May 16 at 11:00 for the Senior Picnic.

If you have not ordered your cap and gown, please contact Graduate Services at 272-5890 as soon as possible. Caps and gowns will be delivered to WCCC. **All questions regarding caps and gowns need to go directly to Graduate Services.**
